
**TO: THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE WESTBANK COMMUNITY LIBRARY DISTRICT AND TO ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:**

*Notice is hereby given that the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of the Westbank Community Library District (the "District") will hold a regular meeting on Thursday, August 26, 2021 at 9:00 AM, online via Zoom. The link is available on the library website (<https://www.westbanklibrary.com/agendas-minutes/>).*

1. Citizen's Communication – Citizens are invited to address the Board. Citizen's Communication is limited to thirty minutes, with each speaker limited to five minutes. Citizens must sign in at the beginning of each meeting and will be heard in the order of arrival.
2. Discuss and approve minutes for the Board meeting on July 15.
3. Discuss and consider the financial reports of the District for June and July of 2021.
4. Discuss and approve the 2nd Quarter Investment Report for 2021.
5. Discuss, consider and approve a Resolution Regarding Pandemic Response and Emergency Suspension of policy.
6. Discuss, consider and approve Resolution Authorization to replace the BBVA account with PNC and related documents.
7. Discuss, consider and approve holidays for the rest of 2021.
8. Discuss, consider, and take action as needed for the November Board election. Schedule future meetings as necessary for compliance with election law regarding possible ballot order drawing or cancellation of election.
9. Discuss and consider the Library Director Report.
10. Consider by staff report, without discussion, such other matters as may come before the Board and as may be necessary to carry out the business of the District, to direct the formulation of agenda items for the next meeting, and to set the date of the next meeting.

The above agenda schedule of indicated items is in a proposed order that may be changed at any time. The Board, therefore, reserves the right to consider and act upon agenda items in an order other than as stated above. The Board also reserves the right to adjourn at any time during the meeting in compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Government Code (the "Act"). The Board may meet in closed session on any of the above items for the following purposes: (i) to consult with the District's attorney in accordance with §551.071 of the Act; (ii) to deliberate with respect to real property matters in accordance with §551.072 of the Act; (iii) to deliberate concerning a proposed gift or donation in accordance with §551.073 of the Act; (iv) to deliberate concerning certain matters with respect to an employee in accordance with §551.074 of the Act; to deliberate regarding security personnel, security devices, or security audits in accordance with §551.076 of the Act. Any matter discussed in closed session may be subject to action in the open session.
